Morningstar Asset Allocation Portfolios Expand the Efficient Frontier

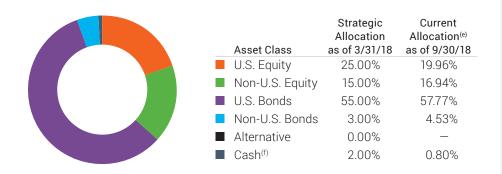


Standard Deviation (Risk)
